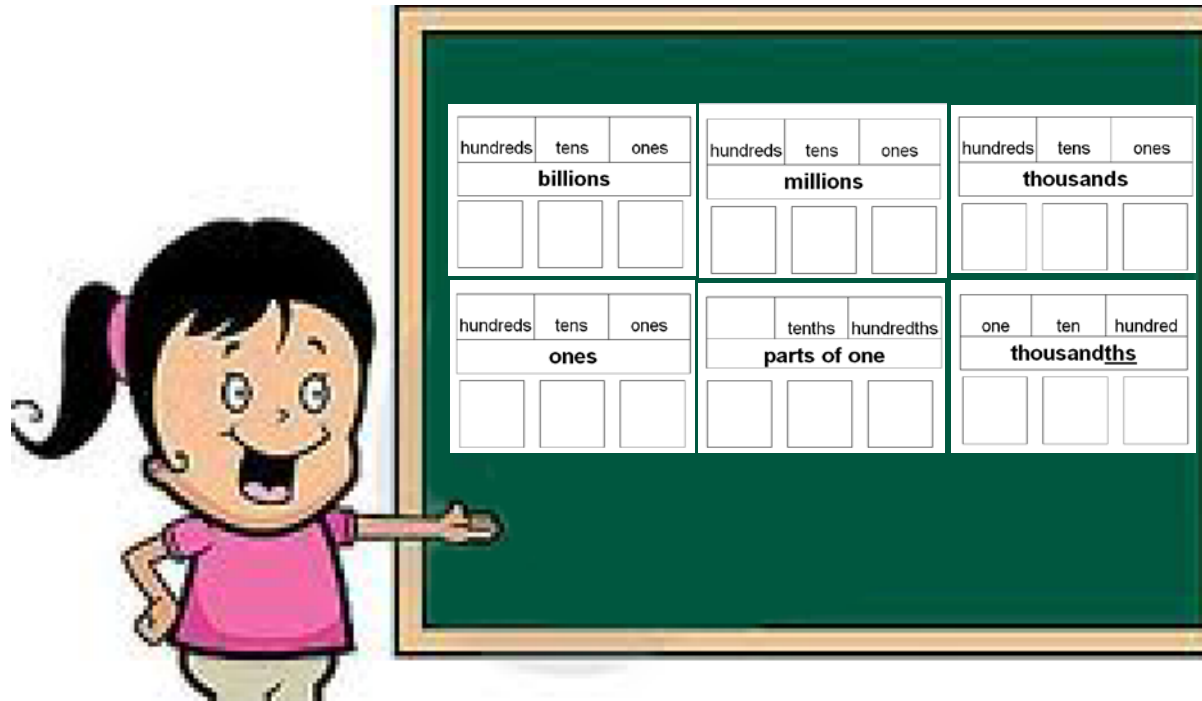




PLACE VALUE CHART







They are a useful tool when trying to support students to read, write and say big and small numbers. They are particularly helpful for students who are struggling with their understandings. Importantly they reflect what is on the individual place value cards which you can find in these resource pages.

Use the place value charts in conjunction with the place value games for numbers up to 120 and the decimal place value game. These games which focus on place value and link to addition and subtraction use unifix cubes, craft sticks and MABs. These games can be found in the place value resources.




